INTRODUCTION

"SCREEN MAN" is following in the same footsteps as "Stone by stone," adding to the previous show new languages. The work as actor, puppets and objects are being accompanied this time by the use of audiovisuals. The simplicity of the stones gives way to the poetry of images. The drama is developed from the dialogue between the digital and the real, in rotation, to advance the plot. A proposal in which the manipulation of images, puppets and objects, situates the audience members into a magical universe that takes place before their eyes, to tell a recognizable story for all ages and therefore, universal. Desires, individual and collective dreams, will give appointment in this tender story that provides a way for their realization: perseverance and passion.

SYNOPSIS:

We walk in life with the desire to make our dreams come true. It's not always easy but the eagerness pushes us to try and try again. Sometimes, by chance, we find in our way a person who helps us to lose fears, doubts and uncertainties until realize our dream. SCREEN MAN is the person on the path of our protagonist. The integration of digital technologies in children and family shows is a fact, *El Teatre de l'Home Dibuixat* incorporates them to their particular poetry to tell a story of today and tomorrow. The protagonist of this show is a child with the illusion of being a clown in a circus. However, his schoolmates do not understand him and make fun of him. The proverbial appearance of Screen Man will open the way to the protagonist's illusions by putting them in value and appeasing their fears. Straddling the traditional puppet show and interactive digital illustration, Screen Man explores the possibilities of coexistence of the two languages before an audience accustomed to all kinds of poetic licenses, in favor of a good story. The little puppet moves easily from the screen to the stage and vice versa and the possibilities of the virtual world multiply the effect of the projection of the protagonist's fantasies. Digital animation becomes not only the scenery of history, but also an inseparable part of it.

"Screen Man", as the same title indicates, is based on the relationship between a man (actor, manipulator) and a screen. We again see the minimalism and precision of the gestures so characteristic of the work of Tian Gombau, which on this occasion applies to the technical filigree of playing with the images that appear animated on the screen and which the actor turns into real objects, into a Constant swing between the two dimensions: the cinema and the reality.
