One day he sees his parents worried. They don't pay attention to him like they used to. His father is a lime maker, an artisan lime manufacturer, but changes are coming for the family.


### **Not so long ago**

This show tells the story of Sagal, the son of a lime maker. Lime used to be a fundamental material for making houses, but there came a time when the way of building changed... and the lime maker's trade disappeared. The man who burned stones had to rebuild himself, and Sagal helped him.

It also talks about the fascination for fire, that dangerous and at the same time essential element for life.

A craft trade, a family living in the rural world, fire and traditional festivals make up the human landscape in which this story unfolds, in a time less distant than it seems.



The Escalante Theatrical Center has produced *My father burned stones*, the latest family show by veteran Tian Gombau, one of the best creators in the Valencian Community in the field of object theater.

Since 1992, he has never ceased to amaze with his magic and sensitivity, the excellent manipulation of puppets and the construction of worlds from simple stories.

This earned him the MAX AWARD in 2020 with *New shoes*, one of his best creations.

*My father burned stones* is a tribute to the old trades that have disappeared and a song to hope. Juanito is a lime maker, a stonemason of lime for houses, accompanied by his sympathetic son and understanding wife . Hard work is passed from father to son, but he doesn't want his son to do it.

But concrete construction grows and he becomes unemployed. He has lost his vision but thanks to his son, luck smiles on him again.

Gombau surprises again with his narrative and visual power. His technique with hand puppets identifiable by their nose is impeccable. But also his range of objects, from the initial blackboard which reveals the white house, in a scenography suitable to reproduce the combination of narrative and execution with beautiful images and shadows, a captivating party of demons of the "Santantonà" and the beautiful blue scene of the sea.

All accompanied by Valencian music with strong presence of our dulzaina.


